FOUNDER OF THE SEA LEAGUE **CHRIS RAGLAND**

UCSB Environmental Studies '12

Chris Ragland is the Founder and Executive Director of The Sea League (TSL) located in Santa Barbara. Established in 2020, TSL aims to address inequality and improve accessibility to blue spaces. As an after-school team sports program, TSL emphasizes nature connection over competition and makes water sports accessible to youth aged 7-14 from all backgrounds. Their mission is to create immersive opportunities for young people to explore, play, and build community in marine habitats through activities such as surfing, stand-up paddling, kayaking, and snorkeling.

Chris graduated from UCSB in 2012, where he researched the impacts of human activity and extreme weather on coral reefs, diving extensively throughout Southeast Asia. He is a lifelong ocean lover with over a decade of experience as a surf coach and kayak guide at the Channel Islands National Park. He serves on the Channel Islands National Marine Sanctuary Advisory Council, advising NOAA on decisions affecting the thriving marine ecosystems surrounding the islands. Chris also sits on the Board of Wilderness Youth Project, which has been promoting happier, healthier, and smarter kids through nature connection for the past 24 years.

COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD



CENTRAL COAST ALLIANCE UNITED FOR A SUSTAINABLE ECONOMY (CAUSE)

Central Coast Alliance United for A Sustainable Economy (CAUSE) is a base-building organization committed to social, economic, and environmental justice for working-class and immigrant communities in California's Central Coast. They build grassroots power through community organizing, leadership development, coalition building, civic engagement, policy research, and advocacy. CAUSE's vision is that, together, we can create a global community where we all contribute to, and benefit from, a sustainable economy that is just, prosperous and environmentally healthy.

CAUSE began as two separate organizations, CAUSE in Ventura County in 2001 and PUEBLO in Santa Barbara County in 2003, which both emerged during the nationwide living wage movement and won milestone victories to create a living wage region on the Central Coast, lifting wages for thousands of workers. In 2013, the two organizations joined forces, and CAUSE took on PUEBLO's work in Santa Barbara County, creating a regional organization for social, economic and environmental justice.
