UCSB Environmental Studies '79

Lynn Rodriguez is a water resource professional with over 40 years of experience in collaborative, multi-benefit water management. She has led major projects in Santa Barbara and Ventura Counties, including the Ventura River Watershed Resilience Pilot Project, Ventura County's Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) Program, and the LA–Ventura Disadvantaged Community Involvement Task Force. Her work focuses on groundwater policy, climate and watershed resilience, drought response, and engagement with Tribal and frontline communities.

Lynn has held leadership roles with the American Water Works Association, California Urban Water Conservation Council, and the Statewide IRWM Roundtable of Regions. She co-founded UCSB's Darcy Aston Memorial Water Lecture Series, now in its 11th year.

In addition to her professional career, she has long been an active advocate for a strong community by serving as a board member of the Santa Barbara Unified School District Board, Santa Barbara Education Foundation board, Alpha Resource Center, Harding School Foundation and others. She has received an award of excellence from the California Urban Water Conservation Council and a Gold Award from California Teachers Association.

She has a passion for all aspects of water stewardship and especially enjoys working with the next generation of water professionals.

COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD



Get Oil Out! (GOO!)

Get Oil Out! (GOO!) is a Santa Barbara-based public interest group founded in 1969, just 24 hours after the infamous blowout on Platform A spilled millions of gallons of oil into the Santa Barbara Channel. Since then, GOO! has been dedicated to ending offshore oil development and reducing society's reliance on fossil fuels.

During the past five decades, 40 federal and 18 state oil leases have been relinquished and the California Coastal Sanctuary, which prohibits new oil leasing within three miles of the coast, was enacted. GOO! worked toward these and many other significant milestones in the fight against oil development, especially in the Santa Barbara Channel. GOO! is currently working relentlessly to oppose new oil projects, including current efforts by Sable Oil Company to restart production on the Santa Ynez Unit using the same corroded pipeline that ruptured in 2015.

GOO! remains committed to ensuring that existing infrastructure, including aging offshore platforms such as Platform Holly, is decommissioned in the most environmentally responsible manner. Through public engagement, policy advocacy, and legal action if necessary, the group continues its mission to end fossil fuel development in the Santa Barbara Channel.
